

SUGARCREEK SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS

The goal of tonight's open house meeting is to provide information about the project and to gain public input on the two alternative shared-use path alignment options being considered. Please feel free to view tonight's exhibits at your own pace.

PROJECT PURPOSE


The purpose of this project is to make bicycle and pedestrian path improvements along Feedwire Road as part of Ohio's Safe Routes to School Program. The improvements were generally identified in the School Travel Plan for Sugarcreek Township and the City of Bellbrook and include the construction of a ten foot wide walking and biking path along Feedwire Road from Bellbrook Middle School to Eden Meadows Way / Roger Scott Drive. This project is the fourth shared-use path project in the immediate area to be developed with Safe Routes to School program funding with the intent of improving safety for students walking and biking to school.

Preliminary engineering for the project investigated two primary alternatives. Option 1 is the alignment option on the south side of Feedwire Road. Option 2 is the alignment option on the north side of Feedwire Road. Specific information about the the scope of the two different options are listed on the back of this sheet.

NEXT STEPS

The next steps are:

- Preliminary design and right of way plans completed by summer 2016
- Right-of-way acquisition, beginning summer 2016, to be completed in 2017
- Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2018

The following provides details about each option.

OPTION 1: SOUTH SIDE OF FEEDWIRE ROAD

1. Construct a 10' wide shared use path along the south side of Feedwire Road from Eden Meadows Way to Bellbrook Middle School driveway.
2. Construct new ADA-compliant curb ramps on all four corners of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Eden Meadows Way.
3. Install crosswalk markings across the east, north, and south legs of the intersection of Feedwire Road at Eden Meadows Way.
4. Install pedestrian crossing signs with rectangular rapid flashing beacons for the crosswalk across the east leg of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Eden Meadows Way.
5. Extend the sidewalks on both sides of Adams Place to meet the shared use path at the south side of the intersection with Feedwire Road. Sidewalks are to be extended by approximately 45 feet on each side of Adams Place.
6. Install crosswalk markings across the south leg of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Adams Place.
7. Replace the existing guardrail on the south side of Feedwire Road at the culvert just east of Adams Place to accommodate the shared use path.
8. Extend the 42-inch culvert east of Adams Place on the south side of Feedwire Road to accommodate the shared use path.
9. Provide railing along the shared use path near the 42-inch culvert.
10. Relocate existing fencing along the south side of Feedwire Road on the eastern end of the project.

OPTION 2: NORTH SIDE OF FEEDWIRE ROAD

1. Construct a 10' wide shared use path along the north side of Feedwire Road from Roger Scott Drive to Bellbrook Middle School driveway.
2. Construct new ADA-compliant curb ramps on all four corners of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Eden Meadows Way.
3. Install crosswalk markings across the east, north, and south legs of the intersection of Feedwire Road at Eden Meadows Way.
4. Install pedestrian crossing signs with rectangular rapid flashing beacons for the crosswalk across the east leg of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Eden Meadows Way.
5. Extend the sidewalks on both sides of Adams Place to the south side of the intersection with Feedwire Road. Sidewalks are to be extended by approximately 45 feet on each side of Adams Place.
6. Install crosswalk markings across the south and east legs of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Adams Place.
7. Install pedestrian crossing signs with rectangular rapid flashing beacons for the crosswalk across the east leg of the intersection of Feedwire Road and Adams Place.
8. Replace the existing guardrail on the north side of Feedwire Road at the culvert just east of Adams Place to accommodate the shared use path.
9. Extend the 42" culvert at approximate east of Adams Place on the north side of Feedwire Road to accommodate the shared use path.
10. Install crosswalk markings across the driveway of Bellbrook Middle School.
11. Construct a curb ramp on the east side of the driveway of Bellbrook Middle School.

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
